
SEMESTER CLASSES

IF DROPPED AFTER THE 5^{TH} DAY IN A CLASS, A WF (0 QUALITY POINTS) WILL BE GIVEN TO THE STUDENT.

HONORS CLASSES

- IF YOU MOVE DOWN FROM AN HONORS CLASS DURING THE COURSE OF THE YEAR, YOUR GRADE WILL TRANSFER TO THE NEW CLASS. QUALITY POINTS WILL REFLECT THE NEW CLASS WEIGHTING IF A MOVE IS MADE.
- ENGLISH HONORS CLASSES HAVE A SUMMER ASSIGNMENT DUE TO THE TEACHER THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL; REGARDLESS OF WHICH SEMESTER YOU ARE ASSIGNED THE CLASS.
